

### **Divine Economy: Spiritual Solution to world's economic ills**

One of the twelve fundamental principles of the Baha'i Faith is a spiritual solution to the economic problem. In our society today we see extreme wealth and extreme poverty, and the majority of the world's wealth is in very few hands. Almost one-fifth of the world's population is considered impoverished and lacking the basic necessities of life, like food and clean drinking water.

Baha'u'llah outlines in his Revelation the means to bring about a just economic system based on spiritual principles—a divine economy. It is to be a capitalist system to preserve and support the entrepreneurial spirit; but it is to be bridled, eliminating extremes of wealth and poverty.

There are many facets to this divine economy, but it is centered on three pillars which, when established, will provide the foundation for economic justice to be realized throughout society. These three pillars are: the establishment of local Storehouses, the Zakat, and the institution of profit sharing.

The first step in creating this divine economy is the establishment of local Storehouses. The storehouses will be established in each village, and its first revenue will be a portion of the farmer's harvest to be redistributed to the poor and needy.

Baha'u'llah says that the farmer is the fulcrum of society, and by basing the divine

economy on agriculture we ensure and protect the local economy of our communities.

By first focusing on building stable local economies, we can then build a strong global economy. The storehouses will have a total of seven revenues and seven expenditures, which are detailed in the Baha'i writings. When these storehouses are functioning, society will no longer be in need of private banks.

The second pillar of the divine economy is the Zakat. Zakat means purification, and is the means Baha'u'llah has prescribed to purify one's wealth through tithing a small percentage of our income minus our expenses for the advancement of society. The Zakat is paid to the local storehouse and is administered by a democratically elected council. The Zakat is used to help ensure that no member of society goes without, to advance the education of the peoples and to pay the administrative costs of the local communities. Baha'u'llah asserts that all people must work—there will be no idle rich and no idle poor. But the Zakat will provide a security blanket, so-to-speak, for those that fall on hard times.

Since all must work, the third pillar of the divine economy is the institution of a system of profit sharing to ensure economic justice between the laborers and the financiers. When the workers have an economic stake in the performance of the



company, they will feel a stronger sense of purpose in their work, and will provide higher quality products and services. Strikes will become a thing of the past, and the financiers will no longer be able to live in luxury at the expense of the workers.

The principles of economic justice stand in stark contrast to the neo-liberal economic policies of globalization that we face to-day—an economy of rape and pillage that benefits a very small group at the expense of the whole. But the current economic system cannot stand much longer, as the way will soon be cleared for the establishment of Baha'u'llah's divine economy, based on these three pillars, ensuring that the whole of mankind can live in prosperity.


#### <sup>5</sup> "Chair Mountain" near Aspen, Co., is the Heartland

This year, at the 2003 International Baha'i Gathering, we saw how the New Jerusalem, described in the Book of Revelation, is located in the Rocky Mountains. The 12 gates of Revelation (Rev. 21:10-13) are the twelve cities on interstate highways that give people access to New Jerusalem in the Rockies. If the Rockies were likened to a human form, Missoula, Montana is where the brain is at. Missoula is where Dr. Jensen taught people to use their intellect to see the proofs for the Kingdom of God in the Baha'i Faith.

It is also the place and establishment of the Ark of the Covenant, and the central headquarters of the IBC/UHJ and the Guardian. Thus it is the head of the faith. Chair Mountain corresponds to where the heart is, in the heartland of New Jerusalem.

We also saw how the Crystal River flows from Marble and Chair Mountain (Rev. 20:11, 22:1). And we saw how Chair Mountain represents the Throne of David, as this area, near Aspen, Co. is where 'Abdu'l-Baha rested, and is also where his great grandson, the third Aghsán Guardian, was publicly revealed to the people at the time of the 9-11 event.




### **Emerging from out of the clouds**
